The Administrative Council (AC) of the European Patent Organisation has elected António Campinos to succeed Benoit Battistelli as President of the EPO. Campinos 5-year term will start on 1 July 2018. According to an [EPO announcement](#), the Portuguese Campinos was elected during the AC meeting in Munich today. He is currently Executive Director of the European Union Intellectual Property Office (EUIPO). As a former president of the Portuguese Patent Institute (INPI), he was the Portuguese representative on the Administrative Council for many years.
